GENERAL RULES

G3 — Rules relating to Academic Board, Faculty Boards and Elections

Part 1 — Academic Board

Division 5 — Academic Board committees

Form of ballot

27. (1) A ballot must be a secret ballot using the quota preferential system. Ballots ~~may~~ **will** be conducted ~~by attendance at a polling booth or~~ by way of an electronic voting system that has been approved for use by the Returning Officer in accordance with Rule G3-29, **unless the Returning Officer determines it necessary to conduct an election by attendance at a polling booth**. ~~Subject to the UTS Act, the By-law and these Rules, the Returning Officer shall determine which method or methods shall be used for any particular ballot.~~

- (2) Ballot papers, or the component of the electronic voting system that records a vote cast by the voter, as the case may be, must contain the names of the candidates in the order drawn at random by the Returning Officer or by a person appointed by the Returning Officer for the purposes of the election.
