

# **APPROVED RULE CHANGES**

Pursuant to the UTS By-law (Part 4, clause 44), the following rule changes have been made by UTS Council.

## UTS STUDENT RULES

### Section 3 – Course and subject requirements

### 3.7 Subject requirements

[...]

3.7.5 For all UTS subjects, the credit point value must be a whole number and must be delivered in a single teaching period (as defined in <u>Schedule 1</u>), noting that teaching periods do not include the completion of related administrative matters (including finalisation of grades and appeals or <u>internships (also called</u> professional practice placements) that extend beyond a teaching period).

# Section 6 — Credit and recognition of prior learning

# [...] 6.5 Credit for professional internships (work experience)

6.5.1 Credit points associated with **professional experience**<u>internship</u> subjects must conform to the work experience in industry requirements of the <u>Higher</u> <u>Education Support Act 2003 (Cwlth)</u> (the Act) and the associated <u>Administration</u> <u>Guidelines 2012 (Cwlth)</u> (the Guidelines).
